Borough Engineer

- The North Main Street Sidewalk project is still waiting for Harrisburg to execute the grant, but the Borough has received a letter of non-prejudice, which allows the Borough to move forward. A pre-construction meeting will be set up, and work should be starting in April. A letter will go out to the residents involved.
- The Main & Afton signal improvement project is currently in design phase.
- The Engineers looked at the old stone foundation of the Mary Yardley Bridge and believe it may be modified, and made safe and able to use.

Mr Bria attended the Yardley-Makefield Fire Company's Annual Banquet, where Borough Businessman and Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator Barry DiNola was honored as Fireman of the Year. Mr Bria notes that the Fire Company has handled an above average number of calls, due to the 4 recent storms in March.

Bill List

- John McCann, 174 N Main St, asks if the Borough could set up a pickup for leaves and branches. Lower Makefield was allowing Yardley Borough residents to bring yard waste to their facility up until March 17th. The Borough will request that again from Lower Makefield.
- Michele Smull, 181 S Canal St, asks if South Canal St is a dedicated street. Council will investigate this.
- Dawn Perlmutter, 18 West College Ave, has concerns about the property at 20 West College Ave, and believes there is work being done without the proper permits, and feels that she is being retaliated against by Borough officials.

• Kim Prickett, owner of 20 West College Ave, states that all work being done on her property is legal and permitted. Ms Prickett would like to be included in future communications that involve her property.

- 1. Adoption of Ordinance No 475 Natural Resources Protection Ordinance.....Mr Bria Mr Bria moves to adopt Ordinance No 475, which is seconded by Mr Ross. This Ordinance would restrict building within 150 feet of a waterway. Ms Brady does not want to put too many restrictions on property owners living near the canal or the river. Ms Brady moves to table the motion which is seconded by Mr Berry. Motion carries, with Mr Bria voting against.

Banner Permit (Yardley 5K) installation 5/21, removal 6/4..................Ms Brady Ms Brady moves to approve the Banner Permit for the Yardley 5K, installation 5/21 and removal 6/4, which is seconded by Mr Berry. A Beer Fest Banner has already been approved for this same time. Motion is withdrawn and tabled, until a decision can be made.
